Bharat Bachpan – Healthy Start to Life for Every Child

We are actively working now in 35 villages. Appreciating our efforts & to prevent malnutrition, government is planning to increase the capacity of the Nutrition Rehabilitation Center (NRC) in Uttoor, Adilabad, from 10 beds to 20 beds. In collaboration with the government, we have initiated a Tele-Coordination Center in Adilabad, covering 7 lakh people. Through this, we counsel pregnant women and facilitate more effective delivery of government services, with focus on high-risk pregnant women.

Water Conservation Awareness – Need of the Hour

A second water conservation awareness meeting was held under the guidance of Telangana Retired Engineers Association, to supplement our untiring efforts. A bore well was dug to supply water to 400 families & water tank was installed, which cheered up the villagers.

Model Primary Health Centre (PHC) – Better Rural Healthcare

Due to generous financial support from several US NRIs, considerable improvements have been made in Burgula PHC and sub-centre in a bid to improve Kayakalp scores and acquire NQAS (National Quality Assurance Standards) Certificate. Our volunteer physicians conduct a monthly medical camp in the village.
