Pragathi Rural Development Centre (PRDC) in Burgula, Telangana, has been a hub for Rural Transformation. We intend to convert it into a model digital technology center, whereby different digital services can be delivered to hundreds of nearby villages.

Our vision is in line with the "Digital Villages" campaign. There are around 6,50,000 villages in India, with 70% of India's population living in these villages. The government of India plans to connect all of India's villages with optic fiber cables.
